









Argentina vs Colombia bettors - activity on earlier stages


Similar to the Euros, nearly 1 in 5 bettors on the final hadn't bet on the tournament. However, more bettors who placed wagers on an earlier stage of Copa left then returned to wager on the final between Argentina and Colombia.

More 17 million unique Bet Builder bets placed during than the 2024 Euros and Copa América


% of bets that were Bet Builders



The percentage of bets which were Bet Builders grew by more than double between the 2021 tournaments and 2024 tournaments.


Euros Bet Builder users were more likely to be retained in later rounds of the tournament

Similarly, Copa América Bet Builder users were also more likely to wager again on later stages, but with a higher percentage of bettors placing a wager on all later stages compared to the Euros




Bet Builder users also showed a greater propensity to bet live on the same event



As esports' popularity continues to rise worldwide, so too does the popularity of betting on such events. For the most die-hard soccer fans, esoccer offers an opportunity to continue wagering on the sport they love in a virtual way during breaks between football seasons, and even in between the matches themselves when seasons are ongoing.

Below is an overview of betting activity observed by Kambi on esoccer throughout the Euros and Copa América.

Esoccer betting activity throughout the entirety of the Euros and Copa tournaments

In the graph below, you will see spikes in betting activity on esoccer in between spikes in betting activity surrounding both the Euros and Copa América tournament matches. Esoccer betting activity continued, even after the completion of both finals on 14 July.



The Euros saw four separate matches played on 25 June. When the final match of the day came to the final whistle, betting activity on esoccer continued to rise.
